The band is moving away from the Remind app and using BandApp. Mr. Myers, instructors, and boosters will communicate with students and parents in this manner. The only exception to this is the guard where instructors will communicate with students through Telegram.

Section leaders will determine the best way to communicate with students within their sections (these are not monitored by instructors) for section-specific reminder reminders, bonding activities such as section gifts, dinners, section outings, end-of-season parties and other section-specific activities.



Additional Guard Items

- All students regardless of gender will need to purchase <u>Capezio Transition Body Tights by August 15th.</u> These can be purchased at Standing Ovation or in Fort Wayne or Mrs. Lank will place a guard order and cost roughly \$30.

- New students will need to purchase Jazz Shoes. We will place this order on JULY 27th. They cost \$40.00. Please make checks payable to DeKalb High School Band
